

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE  
GRAND HAVEN MASTER ASSOCIATION, INC  
REGARDING STREET TREE TRIMMING**

**Be it resolved that by the Board of Directors of the Grand Haven Master Association Inc. that the following rules are adopted and will be added to the official records of the Association.**

In order to allow for individuals to safely walk along the sidewalks and larger commercial vehicles to pass safely through the residential streets of the community, it is required that street trees be trimmed and maintained as follows.

A clearance of seven (7) feet over all sidewalks.

A clearance of nine (9) feet over the curb line.


A clearance of eleven (11) feet over the traffic lane.

A clearance of fourteen (14) feet over the crown of the road.


It should be noted that the above requirements are consistent with the recommendations made by Jason Shaw, I.S.A Certified Arborist.

Live Oak street trees should be allowed to mature naturally. Balling or creative design trimming of these trees is not allowed.

This amended resolution was passed and duly adopted at a meeting of the Board of Directors of the Grand Haven Master Association on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of April 2018.
